Seeding FAQs



WHEN TO SEED

The best time to seed is late spring or early fall when the soil temperatures are at least 7°C



SITE/SEEDBED PREPARATION

Remove any debris and loosen up existing soil with a hard rake or rototiller. If required add additional soil to the area, we suggest using our #1 Garden Soil. Rake the soil level and apply a pre plant fertilizer to the area.



PLANTING

Seed should be applied at a rate of 5lbs/1000ft² for new seeding and 2-3lbs/1000ft² for over seeding. We suggest using a hand or push spreader and applying the seed evenly in 2 separate directions. Once the seed is spread, lightly rake it into the soil covering it with no more than 1/4" of soil.



WATERING

For the first 3-4 weeks keep the soil moist with light waterings and try to avoid standing water.



FERTILIZING

Once the seed is established, approximately 6 weeks after seeding, you can make your first season appropriate fertilizer application. Visit our website, www.fairgreensod.com, for our recommendations.



MOWING

The first mowing should take place once the grass is 2-3 inches tall and the ground is able to support the weight of you and your mower. For best results we recommend mowing your lawn between 2-3 inches in height.

New seeding: 5 lbs/1000ft²
Overseeding: 2-3 lbs/1000ft²
